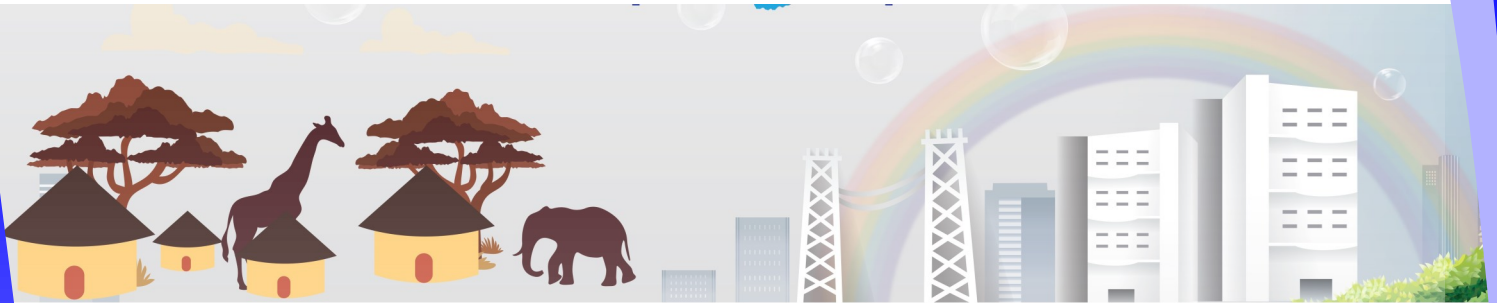


EASTERN AFRICA ROTARY PROJECTS FAIR

Itinerary

Mon., Apr. 29 - Depart North America

Tue., Apr. 30 - Arrival in Mombasa, Kenya: First-class accommodations at the **PridelInn Paradise Beach Resort**, which includes daily breakfasts and internet. This morning is free, as our members will be arriving throughout the night and early morning. This afternoon we will begin our tour of Mombasa Town, the second largest city in Kenya and an island. The city has a diverse and intriguing population, and we will visit some interesting historical and cultural places including, Fort Jesus, the old town, Baobab forest, and Akamba Woodcraft.



Wed., May 1 - Mombasa: Morning tour of local projects of the Rotary clubs of Mombasa. We will be able to see the community needs and Rotary's response to those needs. We enjoy lunch with the local Rotarians before returning to our hotel. Later this afternoon, we join all Projects Fair attendees in a "Koroga," which is a uniquely Kenyan style of dining outdoors.

Thu., May 2 - East African Projects Fair: We attend the Projects Fair and engage with Rotarians from throughout east African nations. Events include the Opening Ceremony and Rotary Foundation seminars where we learn how to support and engage club projects. Tonight, we will participate a cultural night celebrating the 75th Anniversary of the Rotary Club of Mombasa

Fri., May 3 - East Africa Projects Fair: We visit the Fair booths to learn about the projects of the East African clubs and discover how to join them in addressing their humanitarian needs. Lunch is included. Tonight, we enjoy a special closing dinner and entertainment event.

Sat., May 4 - Community Service/Humanitarian Day: Today, we work side-by-side with local Rotarians in their community service projects, at schools, hospitals and other vital community services. Lunch provided by local Rotarians. Special dinner event with the local Rotarians.



Sun., May 5 - Tsavo East National Park – Wildlife Safari: Today is an all day adventure to Tsavo East National Park to see the beauty and splendor of African wildlife in its native habitat. Upon our arrival, and in small vehicles with private guides, we enjoy a morning game drive. Lunch is provided as a tour service. After lunch, we continue on another game drive before we return to Mombasa.

Mon., May 6 - Mombasa: Depart for Home: Flight from Mombasa back to North America.

Special Airfare Note

To give our members the most flexibility and affordability, the tour price ONLY includes ground services; it does not include roundtrip airfare. To secure your roundtrip transportation, you can either secure your own air reservations, use frequent flyer mileage, or request a quotation of air transportation from Howard Tours on the enclosed application.

At the time this folder was published, economy class roundtrip airfare between is approximately \$1100 from the East Coast of the US plus a \$50 service fee. Quotations for other originating cities are available upon request. Once secured, we will reconfirm your flight itinerary and airfare BEFORE purchasing your airline ticket. Airfares are subject to change until tickets are paid for and issued.

Howard Tours has been operating tour programs worldwide for over seven decades. Owned and operated by Rotarians, we have taken thousands of Rotarians overseas to participate in polio eradication days, wheelchair deliveries, and humanitarian missions, and have played a critical role in the creation of the West Africa Project Fair, and now the East Africa Projects Fair, by providing an easy, comprehensive travel program for North American participants.

Rotarian Purpose

The East Africa Projects Fair (EAPF) was modeled on Rotary's West Africa Project Fair, the first in Africa, . It was created by Rotarians to facilitate partnerships and projects that will make a significant contribution to the needs of this continent.

By joining this program, you will work with the local Rotarians to understand how important Rotary is to their communities. You will also have the opportunity to select and support Rotary Foundation projects during the Fair, engage in field work in the local communities, create strong friendships with the East African Rotarians, and participate in hands-on humanitarian and health related field work.

Community Health Program, Hands-on Work Project and East Africa Projects Fair:

The Kenyan Rotarians are planning activities in their local communities so that our members will be able to engage in a hands on humanitarian projects. Our group will have the chance to visit a number of humanitarian project sites to witness the work of Rotary and The Rotary Foundation. Further, we will work with the Kenyan Rotarians, side-by-side, to make a difference in the community. During these activities, you will have extraordinary experiences, develop a unique insight into the life and challenges in Africa, and be in the safety and care of local Rotarians.

Delivery of Documents:

Travel documents will be delivered shortly before our date of departure. We will send documents to you via UPS or other secure delivery method. Please be provide a delivery address file where someone is available to receive and sign for packages during normal business hours. Further, UPS can only deliver to a street address and NOT a Post Office Box.

Passport, Visa and Health Requirements:

All U.S. citizens are required to have a valid passport and Kenyan visa. The cost of obtaining your passport, visa and inoculations are not included in the tour price. It is your responsibility to apply and pay for the following items:

U.S. Passport: Must be valid at least six months after your scheduled return to the U.S.

Kenya Visa for all U.S. citizens: Information on applying for the visa will be sent to you with your trip confirmation materials. Allow three weeks to process the visa application.

Required Inoculations: The Center for Disease Control (<http://www.cdc.gov>) recommend that U.S. citizens are up-to-date on routine vaccines before every trip. These vaccines include measles-mumps-rubella vaccine, diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis vaccine, varicella (chickenpox) vaccine, polio vaccine, and your yearly flu shot. Please consult your physician to determine precautions appropriate for you.

Payments: Send \$600 per person, payable only by check, with application. Remaining payments are due upon request and may be paid by check or credit card. Assign deposit check to : "Howard Tours, Trustee Account," Specify "EAPF 2019" on the lower left corner of the check.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Bank Trustee Account and Financial Responsibilities: Payments are deposited in a Bank of America, Grand Lake Branch, Oakland, California, trustee account, used exclusively for this program. By law, Howard Tours cannot and will not use these funds for any purpose other than to defray the program costs. While the money is in the bank, Bank of America, and NOT Howard Tours, is custodian of the funds. When the travel service companies are paid, Howard Tours will have met its financial and trustee obligation for the travel services involved.

Per Person Tour Prices Include: (1) Double occupancy hotel accommodations; (2) Meals and special events specified in the itinerary; (3) Private motorcoach sightseeing and transfers; (4) English speaking guide; (5) Entrance fees; (6) Tips to local guides, drivers and hotel porters; (7) East Africa Project Fair registration; (8) Community health and service program and all Rotary events and values as stated in the itinerary; and (9) Other Rotary and tour materials.

Prices do NOT include: (1) Any and all airfares; (2) Passport and visa fees, if any; (3) Local airport departure taxes not included in the airline ticket; (4) All insurance; (5) All personal expenses, (e.g., phone, laundry, etc.); (6) All health and medical services, and related expenses; (7) All required travel immunizations, and related expenses; (8) Refunds for missed or unused services; (9) Accommodations in excess of the nights listed in the itinerary; (10) Overnight delivery fees or delivery fees for clients outside the continental U.S.; (11) Meals not specified in the tour itinerary.

Conditions of Prices: Prices are based on the relative value between the U.S. dollar, a projected number of travelers, and the currencies of the countries listed when the tours are priced and the folder is printed. If the exchange rates, airfares, number of people who join the tour, or other travel costs change, the traveler may be assessed any extra charges, or refunds. Prices were set and folder was printed November 10, 2017.

Changes of Itinerary: Howard Tours reserves the right to change the itinerary or services for any reason, including those which may be out of our control, (e.g.,: airline schedule changes, natural disasters, schedule of local Rotarians, etc.) If changes are necessary, the traveler may be assessed any extra charges or refunds.

Cancellations and Other Charges: Cancellations must be made by letter, E-mail, or fax and NOT by telephone. Partial or total cancellation of tour services, regardless of reason, are subject to: (1) Funds that may be withheld or imposed by the airlines, hotels, sightseeing companies, etc.; and (2) A per person Howard Tours' cancellation service fee, prorated before departure, as follows: \$300 up to 46 days before departure, and \$600 within 45 days of departure. Cancellations received within 14 days of the date of departure will be 100% NON-refundable. Travelers whose changes result in rewritten air tickets will be charged whatever penalties the airlines may impose, and a Howard Tours \$50 service fee. Those applying within 45 days of departure will be assessed extra expenses caused by late enrollment, with a minimum charge of \$50 per person. Because the airlines, hotels, etc. impose heavy cancellation fees, we recommend the purchase of "Cancellation Insurance," which is available through Howard Tours.

Responsibility Clause: Howard Tours of Oakland, California, operates these programs as an agent for the travelers who join them, and for the various companies which perform services on land, sea and in the air. Individuals apply for membership and are accepted in these programs on the conditions that Howard Tours and its officers will not be responsible for irregularities, omissions, acts, events, or for any additional expenses due to delays, strikes, military action, riots, airplane hi-jacking, civil disorders, losses, injuries, sickness, damage, political action, and/or other matters related to any personal or property involving any facility, transport services, personnel and/or activity in the operations of this program. Because Howard Tours has no control over flights, sailings, rail schedules, and connections between flights, Howard Tours does not accept any responsibilities for these services. Air tickets, and the related tariff conditions filed with the Civil Aeronautics Board, constitute the sole contract between the airline and the purchaser of the travel program.
