**Mon., May 27- Weissenkirchen:** We cruise through the Studengau and Wachau valleys to Weissenkirchen. Today you can choose a walking tour of Durnstein and a visit to Melk's Benedictine Abbey, or you can opt to hike or bike. Later enjoy wine tasting of world renowned Riesling and Gruner Veltliner wines.

**Tue., May 28- Vienna:** Enjoy a city tour of the "City of Waltzes" including the Opera House, the Imperial Palace and St. Stephen's Cathedral or take a guided bike tour to the Klosterneuburg Monastery.

Alternatively you can hike up Castle Hill for views of the city below. This evening, cruise past the famed Parliament Building as the city turns on her lights.

**Fri., May 31- Budapest/Hamburg:** Fly to Hamburg.
